

MEDICAL DEVICE RE-REGISTRATION APPLICATION: IMPLEMENTATION OF INITIAL MDA RESPONSE WITHIN 14 WORKING DAYS

In accordance with the decision reached at the MDA-*Industry Collaborative Committee* (MICC) Bil.1/2024 dated 6th Feb 2024, it was agreed that MDA will provide initial response to applications for medical device **RE-REGISTRATION** within **14 working days** (from the date the application is assigned to the reviewer).

The elements that will be checked during the initial response are as follows:

- 1. Accurate risk classification of medical device
- 2. Appropriate grouping of medical devices
- 3. An updated clinical evaluation report or performance evaluation report
- 4. An updated quality management system (QMS)
- 5. An updated conformity assessment report and a valid certificate
- 6. An updated declaration of conformity
- 7. An updated post market surveillance and vigilance report for the past 3 to 5 years.

Important Notes:

- Incomplete applications without the above elements will be returned once to the applicant to complete it and/or provide the information and/or particulars and/or documents within 30 working days.
- The application **will be rejected** if any information, particulars or documents as requested are not provided to the MDA within 30 working days or the application is returned without the requested information, particulars or documents.
- However, this will not affect the right of the applicant to make a new application and application fee is not refundable.
